This report reflects how, together, we've raised the bar for families in Northeast Kansas and beyond. From events to daily programming, your generosity continues to make a powerful difference.

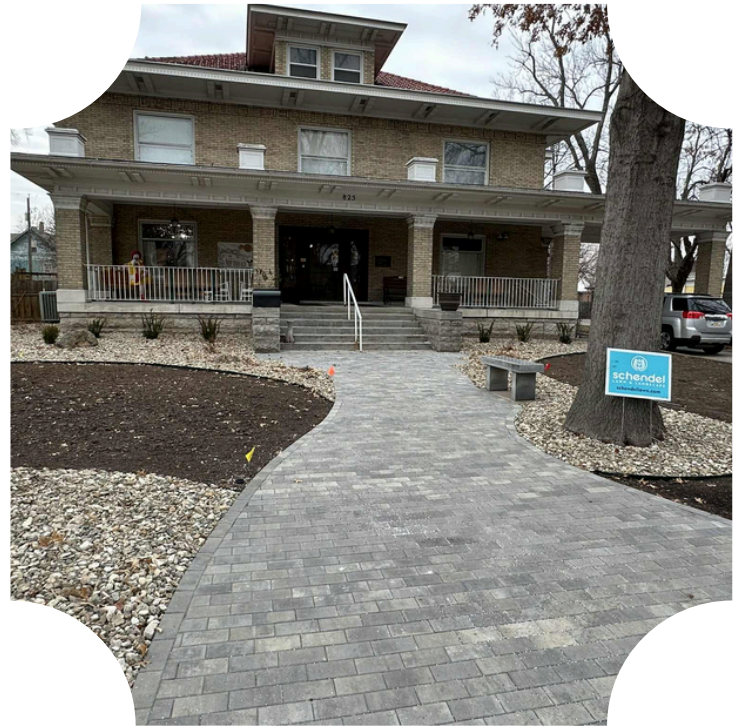
